Students can enrol in Work Experience 15-25-35 and earn up to 10 credits in the summer or 250 hours from June-July.

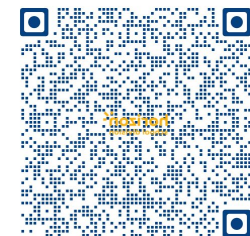

Prerequisites

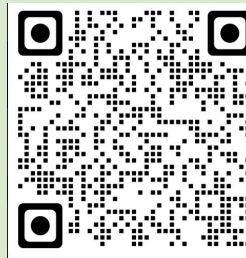
- Completed grade 10

- Site has been visited by Off-Campus Teacher

- You may continue at previous job but must complete the pre-registration form
- If you have a new position, a Program Agreement form is required
- Hours must be submitted at a minimum of 1/month or every 125 hours via the link below:



Hours will only be accepted if student has completed registration and site has been visited.

- Placements must be located within the Horizon School Divisions boundaries.
- If you quit or are fired you will not be able to earn credits for this position.
