

Power Engineer Career Accelerator is a readiness program prior to attending Lakeland College's accredited Power Engineer program or NAIT's Power Engineering Technology program.

Admission Requirements

- Alberta Class 5 Drivers' License (not required but recommended)
- Applicants must either meet Lakeland College's Power Engineer program requirements or NAIT's Power Engineering Technology program requirements
- Successful completion of fitness screening (35lb lift/carry)
- Successful completion of drug & alcohol assessment

This program provides an opportunity for paid learning and employment across Alberta with the program sponsors, Pembina Pipeline and Inter Pipeline.

Cost
